

European & French bets



Inside roulette bets

Straight-up: when you bet on a single number.

Split: a bet on two numbers.

Trio (triple): this is a bet on the numbers 0, 1, 2 or 00, 2, 3.

Street: a bet on three numbers in a line.

Corner (or square): this is when you bet on four numbers in a square layout.

Five number: a bet that covers five numbers (e.g. 30, 11, 36, 13, 27).

Six line (or double street): a bet that covers six numbers in two lines.

Outside roulette bets

Column bets: this is a bet placed on a column of twelve numbers in one of the three vertical lines (such as 1-4-7-10 on down to 34). You place the betting chip on the space below the final number of the sequence.


Dozen bets: a bet on the first (1-12), second (13-24), or third (25-36) group of twelve numbers.

Red / black: a bet that the winning number will be either red or black.


Even / odd: a bet placed on the winning number being either even or odd.

Low / high: a bet that the winning number will be either a low (1-18) or high (19-36).
